6th AEC+8 Gems & Jewelry President's Summit

Thai Gem and Jewelry Traders Association (TGJTA)'s president Mr. Suttipong Damrongsakul, along with TGJTA's board of directors, has attended the 6th AEC+8 Gems & Jewelry President's Summit held during August 3rd and 4th, 2017 in the city of Naypyidaw, Myanmar. The event was hosted by Myanmar Gem and Jewelry Entrepreneurs' Association (MGJEA)

The participants at the summit were presidents of leading gems and jewelry organization from 18 countries from the AEC+8. The meeting has unanimously appointed president of TGJTA Mr. Suttipong Damrongsakul as the first Chairman of AEC+8 President Summit for the period of two years. It is absolutely an honor for Thailand to receive acceptance from all the leaders from 18 countries.

Meanwhile, key topics at the summit included supply chain in the industry, and the improvement's direction for gem and jewelry business in the AEC+8 region. The host, Myanmar, also confirmed that they are still rich in raw materials. They hosted an auction for jade, ruby and other gemstones during the summit. Highlight of the auction was the jade sold at 12 million Euro. During their trip in Myanmar, the TGJTA's executives visited local gems and jewelry market, and the biggest jade market in country.
